“Yamanashi Cultural Experience” is a project to introduce the history and culture of Yamanashi Prefecture with the aim of having foreigners living in Yamanashi Prefecture deepen their understanding of Yamanashi Prefecture.



English-Guided Tour

甲斐善光寺の歴史と甲州印伝

As for the origin of Kai Zenkoji temple, Takeda Shingen, who was said to be the strongest warlord in Japan in the middle of the 16th century, was afraid that the famous Zenkoji temple in Nagano would be burnt up in the Battle of Kawanakajima and had the main Buddhist image and its standing-in-front Buddhist image and almost all the other Buddhist things transferred to Kofu and started the construction of this temple in 1558. There is a tour of the underground altar which forms the Chinese character of “heart,” and it’ll be a rare experience for you to walk in the pitch-black hallway. It is said that when you touch the secret lock during the tour, you’ll have ties with Amida Buddha or Amitabha. You can also experience making Japan’s largest “Crying Dragon” to cry. In addition, you can look at many treasures. In the Museum of Koshu-Inden Deerskin Products, you will look at the deerskin products and their materials, which are a unique and popular Yamanashi-born brand boasting about 400-year-old history. All the explanations during the tour will be given in English.
